This exhibit presents key excerpts from the official Womack Family Trust documentation dated May 25, 2021.

It confirms that Faye I. Womack (Settlor and Trustee) created an irrevocable trust governed under South Carolina law.

Key Legal Highlights:

1. The Trust is explicitly stated to be IRREVOCABLE. No party-including the Settlor-may alter, revoke, or terminate it.
2. Section 1.04 confirms that Faye I. Womack transferred all listed assets to the trust and retained no right, title,
or interest in any property once transferred. This includes real estate, insurance policies, and all Schedule A property.
3. Public declarations made by Faye I. Womack to the Aiken County Assessor's Office in 2022 deny trust ownership,
in direct contradiction with these sworn trust provisions.
4. This contradiction opens the possibility for claims of perjury, tax fraud, or concealment of inherited assets
from the estate of Roland R. Womack, who passed away in 2018.

This document is the foundational legal basis for contesting Faye I. Womack's exclusive control of assets believed

to be shared or derived from Womack family inheritance.
